Wöhlk launches multifocal monthly lens

They are manufactured using the mold process from the company's own bio-hydrogel Vitafilcon A. The established spheric and toric versions are now joined by the multifocal version, CONTACT LIFE. multi spheric. As with the other monthly disposable lenses, the gentle edge profile is also included here. This is slightly rounded and performs two functions at once: The tear film under the contact lens is optimally exchanged and the eye is better supplied with oxygen.

"We owe the fact that we can launch this new product on the market not least to the fact that we received our MDR certificate last fall," explains Dirk Reschat, Head of Quality Management at Wöhlk. "The design development had already been completed, but it is only under MDR that medical technology manufacturers like us are allowed to launch new products. Now we have been able to complete all the technical documentation and finally launch sales." Schönkirchen is certain that customers in Germany and internationally will react positively to this news. "Presbyopia is widespread and the demand for multifocal vision aids is increasing. We are delighted that we can now offer our customers our popular monthly disposable lens in a multifocal version. The Vitafilcon A material has already been awarded the SICCA prize and has proven its worth in recent years," explains Torven Ziehmer, Deputy Managing Director of Wöhlk Contactlinsen GmbH.

The CONTACT LIFE. multi spheric is a multifocal spherical monthly disposable lens for the treatment of presbyopia. Thanks to the bio-hydrogel, it is particularly suitable for patients who experience dry eye or in drier climatic conditions. It is also a good choice for wearers with a lipid-rich tear film or those who work a lot at a computer. This monthly lens can be ordered as a single blister and box of 6 as CONTACT brand, ZEISS CD30 compatic and as a private label and covers a



delivery range from -8.00 to +6.00 diopters. The product is available to all registered customers in the contact lens manufacturer's online store at shop.woehlk.com.

As both the Vitafilcon A material and the monthly disposable lenses are manufactured in Schönkirchen, these contact lenses are 100% made in Germany.
